Participate in the [Park & Wildlife Management](#) internship as part of an ongoing project on a reserve in the Greater Kruger area of South Africa. Activities includes monitoring wildlife populations, birds and biodiversity, vegetation surveys, data collection and capture, as well as general park management.



The emphasis of the [Carnivore Conservation](#) internship in Namibia is on monitoring large predators such as cheetahs, leopards, hyenas, African wild dogs and elephants depending on the research site. Activities involve radio tracking, monitoring camera traps, conducting game counts, some animal care of various African species, and assisting with vegetation surveys.



Take this opportunity and work closely with marine biologists in the [Marine Conservation](#) program in South Africa. It offers interns the opportunity to study shark behavior, Cape Fur seals, whales and other marine life, assist with penguin conservation, enjoy shark cage diving and whale watching. You will also prepare the boats for daily trips depending on the weather conditions.
