Event: Hybrid Timber - Low Carbon and Long Spans



On January 24th, <u>WoodWorks</u>, along with MTI, and <u>DIALOG</u> will be hosting a presentation of the Hybrid Timber Floor System (HTFS), developed in a collaboration between EllisDon and Dialog. The system is the result of a research and development effort that began in 2021 to create a low carbon alternative to steel and concrete construction for long spans. A hybrid mass timber and concrete system, the HTFS has been designed to span up to 40ft. Currently being tested in full scale prototypes, the team is preparing the system for commercial applications. This forum will explore the process of developing the HTFS, and its future in the mass timber industry. The event will take place at the Faculty Club, at the University of Toronto.
