

His research integrates advanced digital fabrication technologies and human-machine interactive design with eco-friendly construction materials (i.e. timber and wood-based products) to embrace new design frameworks and principles for sustainable structural systems.

Highlights from this Episode:

"We became a development company, became our own GC, we became our own erector - it was the nascence of the vision that Nordic is today...if we're going to be promoting a product, we have to be able to offer a service that's beyond the tradition"

"When you build a boutique project, that's great, but the promise of mass timber is also its replication and its ability to standardize construction"

"We started working with the Cree community to bring a sawmill back that was going to be in their community"
